- **Third program evaluation by High Council of Public Health (HCPS)**
 - **pain management conditions vs. pain management itself**
 - **hospital vs. primary care**
 - **weak support of some risk populations (ex. pain in mental health)**
 - **financial liabilities of 21.7 m€but weak tracking**
 - **weak cooperation between parts of French health authorities**
