DIMDI - Topics

- provide broad information in medicine: host services
 (>70 databases; 30 for free; > 100 Mio. documents)
- International medical classifications for Germany
 - ICD, OPS, UMDNS, MeSH
- Information systems on legal base
 - Information system on drugs
 - Information system on medical devices
- German Agency for HTA (DAHTA)
 - Research: HTA reports
 - Information system HTA

HTA – international scientific standard

- systematic evaluation of procedures and technologies based on scientific available information / literature
- aspects of assessment
 - Efficacy, effectiveness, safety, cost-effectiveness
 - Ethical, social, legal discussion
- basic for decision (health policy)
 - distribute the financial resources more effectively
 - identification of scientific and of research needs
 - support for prioritisation of future research activities






