## **Societal Impact of Pain (SIP) Activities at EFIC Congress**

**from 3-7 September 2019 in Valencia, Spain**

### **Relevance of EFIC Congress 2019 for SIP**

- The bi-annual EFIC congress is an important event to bring different stakeholder in the area of pain together (HCP, Patient representatives and industry)
- The topics of Societal Impact of Pain (SIP) gets increasing attention from these stakeholder groups
- EFIC 2019 is a great opportunity to raise awareness about the relevance that pain has on individuals and the society
